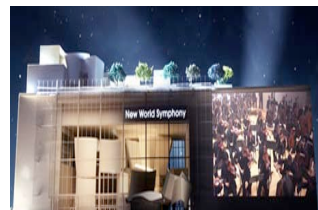

On the Beach

A recent New York Times story, on Miami restaurants, noted a migration of NY, restaurants; Asia de Cuba, La Goulue, Joe Allen and Sushi Samba. In top hotels; Mr. Chow, in the hot somewhat new "W" Hotel, Asia de Cuba, in Schrager's new, Mondrian Hotel, Il Mulino, in Starwood's Aqualina. BICE in Viceroy, Emeril's, at Loews, Nobu at Shore Club, David Bouley, at Ritz-Carlton, Cipriani is developing a new hotel on the beach. Canyon Ranch with their 1st urban complex of 4 towers, also on the beach. From London, we have Balans, on Lincoln RD. and Hakkasan in the Fontainebleau, originally designed by Morris Lapidus in 1953 for \$12 Million (MIMO/Miami Modern Style), recently completed a \$1 Billion restoration and the creation of a new very "hip" place to stay. Echo's of the Art Deco era, can be seen, in small boutique hotels throughout South Beach.
